

Hometown Hero Nomination Form

- Please complete and return the form, along with a one page (double spaced) typewritten statement about your nominee to the Greater Chattanooga Area American Red Cross, 801 McCallie Ave., Chattanooga, TN 37403. Use the essay to tell a compelling story about why your nominee should be selected as a Red Cross Hometown Hero.
- **Nomination forms must be received by February 1, 2011.** Nomination forms and essays become the property of the Red Cross and will not be returned.
- The Hometown Hero judging committee will be comprised of civic volunteers and community leaders. This group will select the finalists and award winners. All nominations will be verified by a representative of the American Red Cross. Decisions are final.
- Nominees must be from the following counties in the greater Chattanooga Area: Hamilton, Bledsoe, Grundy, Sequatchie, Rhea, Marion, Catoosa, Dade and Walker.
- The nominee must be available for promotional events and be able to attend the Hero luncheon. The American Red Cross will host each winner and one guest (two guests for Youth finalists) at the luncheon.
- All finalists must sign information release forms authorizing the Red Cross unlimited permission to use, publish and republish information about them and use their likeness.
- While many nominees exhibit lifelong heroic behavior, nominators must highlight at least one event or situation within the last two years.
